<p>Qualification Description</p> <p>This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work as deckhands in the fishing sector of the seafood industry. In this role, these individuals undertake routine deckhand duties aboard a vessel, such as working ropes, assisting in anchoring and mooring, and assembling and repairing netting under the direction of a supervisor. They also maintain the temperature of seafood catch.</p> <p>The environments in which these individuals work include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • aquaculture farms using wild caught broodstock or seedstock • fishing vessels • charter vessels. <p>All work is carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety, food safety, biosecurity and environmental regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace.</p> <p>The MAR units in the elective bank are subject to licencing and regulatory requirements. These units must be implemented in line with the requirements of the <i>MAR Maritime Training Package</i>.</p> <p>No occupational licencing, legislative or certification requirements to apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>
