RGR50118	Diploma of Racing (Racehorse Trainer)
<p>Qualification Description</p> <p>This qualification reflects the role of individuals licensed to operate a business that trains horses commercially for multiple owners to compete in industry-regulated events in the harness or thoroughbred racing codes. The trainer at this level generally manages a large training establishment with several staff members, often operating interstate and/or internationally, with extensive demands from owners, media and public.</p> <p>The qualification covers high-level technical, planning and management skills required to manage a complex business as well as detailed knowledge of the rules relating to racing partnerships and syndication, and horse pedigree, conformation and animal physiology.</p> <p>This qualification is required for industry licensing and registration in some states and territories. Refer to the relevant state or territory Principal Racing Authority for current requirements.</p> <p>Competencies attained in the units packaged for this qualification will apply to the harness and thoroughbred codes of the industry. Consequently, when performance criteria are applied they will relate to the harness or thoroughbred code and a Diploma of Racing (Racehorse Trainer) must contain a statement as follows:</p> <p>'This qualification was achieved under the conditions operating in the [<i>insert relevant racing code - harness OR thoroughbred</i>] code of the racing industry.'</p>	
<p>Entry Requirements</p> <p>To undertake this qualification the individual must have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> extensive skills and knowledge commensurate with <i>RGR40118 Certificate IV in Racing (Racehorse Trainer)</i> demonstrating industry-relevant experience in the care, welfare and management of horses. 	
<p>Packaging Rules</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 12 units of competency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 7 core units plus 5 elective units. <p>Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 from the electives listed below up to 2 from the electives listed below, or any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
