<p>Qualification Description</p> <p>This qualification reflects the role of workers who are responsible for the administration and day to day business operations of an agricultural or horticultural production enterprise, allows individuals to develop agribusiness skills and knowledge within the agriculture and production horticulture industry.</p> <p>At this level, workers will generally be autonomous and may be required to supervise and lead other workers or teams. Work may take place in a range of industry sectors and in a complex, regularly changing environments. They may undertake a range of complex and non-routine tasks related to the administration of an agribusiness.</p> <p>The range of technical skills and knowledge is proficient and leadership of others would be expected. Job roles vary across different industry sectors and include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▲ Agribusiness administrator <p>No occupational licensing, legislative or certification requirements are known to apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>	
<p>Entry Requirements</p> <p>There are no entry requirements for this qualification.</p>	
<p>Packaging Rules</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 units of competency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-3 core units plus • 11-9 elective units. <p>Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select at least 9-7 units from the elective list • up to 2 units 2 units aligned to AQF levels 3, 4, or 5 may be selected from the elective list from, or this or any other endorsed Training Package or Accredited Course. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▲ Selected units must be relevant to job outcomes in rural business and must be chosen to ensure the integrity of the qualification outcome at AQF level 4.
