<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>This skill set reflects the work required to safely participate in a team responding to a large animal incident. It covers assessing risks and hazards, working safely and using recognised manual manipulation techniques with compromised animals at incident scenes. It applies to large animals, typically horses, cattle and sheep, and other domesticated animals that require at least two people to lift or move.</p>
