<p>Description</p> <p>This skill set reflects the work required to safely participate in a team responding to a large animal incident involving lifting operations and potentially complex technical rescues of large animals from a variety of situations. It applies to large animals, typically horses, cattle and sheep, and other domesticated animals that require at least two people to lift or move.</p>
