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# Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of people who undertake activities related to timber warehousing, transport and distribution and customer sales in the timber wholesales, hardware and timber supply and/or timber manufacturing sectors.

This qualification has several employment pathways for typical operational environments and job roles in the timber building products supply sector:

- Timber Yard / Warehouse Assistant
- Timber Yard Operator
- Warehouse Store Person
- Warehouse Pick & Pack Staff
- Forklift Driver
- Warehouse and Logistics Coordinator
- Transport & Dispatch Coordinator
- Delivery Person
- Counter Sales Officer
- Customer Service Officer
- Sales Representative

This qualification is also designed to provide an industry recognised skills profile and various employment and vocational training pathways for specialised work as warehouse, logistics and customer sales operators related to the supply of timber building products.

This qualification enables specialisations in:

- Warehousing,
- Logistics, or
- · Customer Sales.

Individuals with this qualification apply a broad range of specialised skills and knowledge in varied contexts that involve processing orders and controlling stocks, transporting products, engaging with and selling to customers, and finding solutions to routine problems as they arise. They also take responsibility for their own organisation and outputs at the workplace.

Some imported units in the elective bank are subject to licensing, legislative/regulatory/certification requirements. These units must be implemented in line with the requirements outlined in the unit's parent Training Package.

## Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 15 units of competency:
  - 3 core units plus
  - 12 elective units.
