It describes the skills and knowledge required for individuals to interpret animal behaviour, apply animal learning theory, and to evaluate best practice approaches, to meet the welfare needs of animals and provide ethical services and consumer protection for owners/clients.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

#### **Entry Requirements**
