Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work with crocodiles either on crocodile farms or in the wild. If working with crocodiles in captivity, these individuals undertake a range of routine tasks such as handling, feeding and monitoring stock, and monitoring environmental conditions under the direction of a supervisor. If working with crocodiles in the wild, these individuals assist with data collection and survey activity under the direction of a supervisor.

The environments in which these individuals work include:

- crocodile farms
- hatcheries and nurseries
- crocodile theme parks
- Northern Australian waterways

All work is carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety, food safety, biosecurity and environmental regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace. Licences or permits may be required for the use of firearms or restricted drugs on crocodiles if operating vehicles.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at this time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:
