#### Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

- performed survey equipment test
- maintained survey equipment and material
- · interpreted existing plans and client brief
- read maps and plans
- · recorded levels of survey items and site features
- · orientated a landscape site
- used survey equipment on a sloping site, including a change point
- · analysed surveying and levelling results
- mapped orientation and levels and issues of levels to scale on a site plan
- · booked and logged results
- · produced scale drawings for designs and costings
- liaised with clients.

## **Knowledge Evidence**

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- principles and practices of establishing site levels, including:
  - · survey equipment testing, calibration and maintenance procedures
  - techniques for surveying differing and unusual garden shapes
  - tools, equipment, and surveying instruments relevant to surveying and establishing site levels for landscape projects.
