<p>Qualification Description</p> <p>This qualification describes the skill and knowledge for work activities undertaken by an equine service provider or skilled worker in an equine establishment who provides specialist technical skills. They may work autonomously as small business operators or as part of a management team in an equine establishment. The job roles covered in this qualification are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fitness and performance trainer • horse educator • gear fitter and checker • head groom. <p>All work must be carried out to comply with workplace procedures, in accordance with state/territory work health and safety, animal welfare and biosecurity codes, regulations and legislation that apply to the workplace.</p> <p>No other licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>	
<p>Entry Requirements</p> <p>Prior to commencing this qualification, individuals must have evidence of current skills and knowledge and to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • have completed the following units of competency (or equivalent) and any required prerequisite units of competency (*) prior to commencement of this qualification: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ACMEQU2X12 Handle horses safely or ACMEQU202 Handle horses safely or SISOEQU001 Handle horses or RGRPSH201 Handle racehorses in stables and at trackwork • ACMEQU3X6* Provide routine care for horses • ACMNEW3X1* Work safely in equine workplaces <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • have relevant equivalent experience. 	
<p>Packaging Rules</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 units of competency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7 core units plus • 8 elective units. <p>The electives are to be chosen as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • up to 2 units from Group A • up to 6 units from Groups B to E • up to 2 units from this or any other endorsed training package or accredited course. <p>Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome.</p> <p>Any combination of electives that meets the packaging rules above can be selected for the award of the <i>ACM40X21 Certificate IV in Equine Care</i>.</p> <p>Where appropriate, electives may be packaged to provide a qualification with a specialisation area as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least 3 units from Group B electives for the award of the Certificate IV in <i>Equine Care (Fitness and performance training)</i> 	

- at least 3 units from Group C electives in for the award of the Certificate IV in *Equine Care (Horse educator)*.
- at least 2 units from Group D electives in for the award of the *Certificate IV in Equine Care (Gear fitter and checker)*

Where two specialisations are completed, award of the qualification would read (for example), *Certificate IV in Equine Care (Fitness and performance training and Horse education)*.
