These individuals may apply their specialist skills in one or more of the following pulping and papermaking operational areas:

- wet end
- dry end
- pulping
- · stock preparation and handling
- chemical recovery
- electrical power generation
- · paper finishing and converting
- primary resource
- steam generation
- · recovered fibre
- water services.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply this qualification at the time of publication, however a High Risk Work Licence may be required depending on the type of equipment used for the steam and power generation unit sectors.
