Discretion and judgement in selecting and operating equipment, coordinating resources and applying contingency measures during work.</p> <p>Work must comply with work health and safety and environmental regulations and legislation that apply to the workplace.</p> <p>No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>							
<p>Entry Requirements</p> <p>There are no entry requirements for this qualification.</p>							
<p>Packaging Rules</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 17 units of competency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 core units plus • 11 elective units. <p>Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. Any combination of electives that meets the packaging rules can be selected for the award of the Certificate III in Protected Horticulture.</p> <p>Where appropriate, electives may be packaged to provide a qualification with a specialisation area as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 3 electives must be selected from Group A electives must be selected for the award of the Certificate III in Protected Horticulture (Picking) • At least 3 electives must be selected from Group B for the award of the Certificate III in Protected Horticulture (Packing). • At least 3 electives must be selected from Group C for the award of the Certificate III in Protected Horticulture (Crop Work) • At least 3 electives must be selected from Group D for the award of the Certificate III in Protected Horticulture (Nursery) • Plus 8 units with up to 3 from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course. <p>Where a specialisation area is not sought, the electives are to be chosen as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 units must be from groups A, B, C, D or E • 3 units must be from the remaining units listed in groups A, B, C, D or E or any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
