### AHC305XX Certificate III in Poultry Production

### **Qualification Description**

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required to work safely and effectively in a range of skilled roles in the commercial poultry industry, including poultry farm hand, poultry breeder, egg grader, and poultry contractor.

Individuals in these roles perform poultry and/or egg production tasks under broad direction which involve discretion and judgement in handling, moving, housing, feeding and routine health care. They take responsibility for their own work, carry out assigned tasks, coordinate processes and tasks, work to schedules, operate equipment, solve problems and comply with regulatory requirements. Work environments may include farms and breeding facilities for a variety of poultry species.

The qualification allows for specialisation in:

- Poultry farm hand
- Poultry breeder
- Egg grader
- · Poultry contractor.

Commonwealth and/or state/territory health and safety, animal welfare, environmental protection and biosecurity legislation, regulations and codes of practice apply to keeping of and working with poultry, including the handling of fertilised eggs. Food safety regulations and codes also apply that are sold for human consumption. Requirements vary between jurisdictions.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

#### Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

#### Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 16 units of competency:
- 7 core units plus
- 9 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. Electives can be chosen to provide a general qualification or a qualification with a specialisation.

For the award of the Certificate III in Poultry Production choose:

- at least 9 units from the electives in Groups A to E
- up to 2 units from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

For the award of the Certificate III in Poultry Production (Poultry farm hand) choose:

- at least 4 units from the electives in Group A, including AHCPLY302X Brood Poultry
- up to 5 units from the electives listed in Groups A to E (not already selected)
- up to 2 units from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

For the award of the Certificate III in Poultry Production (Poultry breeder) choose:

- at least 4 units from the electives in Group B, including AHCPLY201X Collect store and handle eggs from breeder flocks
- up to 5 units from the electives listed in Groups A to E (not already selected)

- up to 2 units from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

For the award of the Certificate III in Poultry Production (Poultry contractor) choose:

- at least 4 units from the electives in Group C, including:
- AHCPMG412 Develop a pest management plan
- AHCPMG409 Implement a pest management plan
- up to 5 units from the electives listed in Groups A to E (not already selected)
- up to 2 units from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

Where two specialisations are completed, award of the qualification would read (for example), Certificate III in Poultry Production (Poultry farm hand, Poultry breeder).

At least 6 of the 9 electives selected must be coded at indicative AQF level 3 or above or reflect AQF level 3 outcomes or above.
